1. H. Victoros (Elementary Teachers' of Toronto Local)/K. Fry ((Elementary Teachers' of Toronto Local)

That ETFO, through OTF lobby the Ontario Teacher's Pension Plan to reverse the decision to outsource the 38 OPSEU and 12 management positions which is supposed to come into effect January 2017.

2. D. Wildman (Ottawa-Carleton Occasional Teacher Local)/S. Maudsley (Toronto Occasional Teacher Local)

That ETFO amend Policy Statement, 51 Negotiations, by the addition of a new section to read:

- " 1.0 That clauses that disadvantage any ETFO Bargaining Unit not be included in an ETFO Central Table Agreement."
- 3. D. Wildman (Ottawa-Carleton Occasional Teacher Local)/ A. Chevis (Simcoe County Occasional Teacher Local)

That ETFO conduct a multi-media campaign in the 2016-17 school year, in preparation for the next round of bargaining, to draw public attention to the underfunded and under-resourced inclusionary model and the impact this has on high needs students and their classmates in the elementary public school system.

4. G. Barbour (Upper Grand Teacher Local)/K. Pederson (Upper Grand Teacher Local)

That ETFO, through OTF, demand the reversal of the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan's decision to outsource staff thereby eliminating union jobs.

5. K. Fry (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local) /J. Lachica (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local)

That ETFO sign onto and endorse the Leap Manifesto and distribute information pertaining to the Leap Manifesto through ETFO publications such as Voice magazine, the website (etfo.ca) & environmental workshops.

6. K. Fry (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local) / H. Victoros (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local)

That ETFO lobby the Canadian Labour Congress to take a much stronger and clearer position in opposition to the Trans Pacific Partnership Trade Deal.

7. D. White (Peel Teacher Local)/S. Dénommée (Peel Teacher Local)

That where Native Second Language bursaries are not fully awarded by the April 30th deadline, the ETFO Awards Committee consider applications from members who have taken a Native as a Second Language AQ Course, or a Native as a Second Language workshop/conference during the bursary time period.
