That ETFO create a comprehensive, multi-year, public relations campaign informing teachers and the public of ETFO's concerns with EQAO and other similar testing.

That Committee Chairs be invited by the Executive to attend one Executive meeting each year, and to report to the Executive on the activities of the Committee.
