GENERAL SESSION 6

1. J. Smith (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local)/P. Whyte (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local)

AMR 37

That a task force of the Executive be established to examine the feasibility of developing a common benefit plan for all ETFO members with a report to the February, 2011, Representative Council.

2. T. Cunningham (Peel Teacher Local)/M. Curran (Peel Teacher Local)

AMR 38

That a task force of the Representative Council be established to examine provincial and local issues in providing service to ETFO members in year-round schools as well as when local offices are shut down with a report with recommendations to the February, 2011, Representative Council.

3. D. Andrews (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local)/F. Samuel (Elementary Teachers of Toronto Local)

AMR 41

That ETFO provide the Annual Meeting agenda, voting cards, delegate name tags, and registration forms in English and French to all delegates.

That commencing 2011-2012, ETFO donate \$45,000 annually to the Lieutenant Governor's Aboriginal Literacy Program, supporting the Lieutenant Governor's Summer Reading Camps and the Lieutenant Governor's Club Amick Program, for a five (5) year period, charged to budget line 75020 – the Political Action and Public Relations Fund (PA/PR Fund).

That ETFO create a voice care workshop which would be available for locals to access regionally or locally.

That effective September 2010, all daily casual occasional teacher members who participate in ETFO activities for which release time has been budgeted, receive the daily casual occasional teacher rate set out in their collective agreement for each day of participation, including days that are Professional Activity days in their district school board.
